LAMP OPENING MAGNETS

WE HAVE SEEN A LARGE NUMBER OF VESSELS WITH THE LOCKS BROKEN OFF. THIS RESULTS MAINLY FROM LAMPS BEING BANGED DOWN ONTO THE BENCH BLOCK MAGNETS, AFTER A WHILE THE LOCKS BREAK OFF.

IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO REPAIR THEM.

THE PROBLEM IS A COMBINATION OF DIRT IN THE LOCKING PINS AND WEAR ON THE POLES ON THE MAGNET.

WE WOULD RECOMMEND SCRAPPING ALL YOUR BENCH BLOCK MAGNETS AND REPLACING THEM WITH THE NEW HANDHELD MAGNETS. THEY COME IN PAIRS AND ARE EXTREMELY POWERFULL, THEY ONLY COST £10 AND WILL SAVE YOU A LOT OF BROKEN VESSELS WHICH COST £80+ TO REPLACE.

BE CAREFUL NOT TO TRAP YOUR FINGERS BETWEEN THEM AND ANY FERROUS METAL.

BY USING THESE IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO BREAK OFF THE LOCK.

YOUR LAMP ROOM STAFF NEED TO FOLLOW THE STANDARD INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING AND CLEANING THE LAMPS WHICH WILL KEEP THE LOCKING PINS WORKING FOR MUCH LONGER. IF YOU HAVE VESSELS WITH LOCKS THAT ARE REALLY DIRTY USE WD40 AND AN AIRLINE TO BLOW OUT THE DIRT.
